
A Longstanding Legacy. A New Name.

For thirty years, the school operated under the name Etobicoke Montessori School, earning the confidence of local families and full accreditation from Montessori Canada. In 2025, we reopened as The Mint School with a new name, a new identity, and a renewed sense of purpose. This change reflected a thoughtful and deliberate evolution.

The Most Formative Years

The Mint School serves children from 18 months to six years old, a critical period when the brain develops more rapidly than at any other stage of life. These years lay the foundation for future growth, and at The Mint School, we approach these years with the care they deserve.

Our approach is rooted firmly in authentic Montessori principles. But what sets us apart is how we build on that foundation, placing greater emphasis on enriching our curriculum, and fostering a culture of harmony that feels natural, not contrived.




AN ENRICHED CURRICULUM

Our signature Enriched Whole Child Curriculum brings greater emphasis to early literacy, STEM, logic games, music, art, athletics, and wellness. We teach each element with care to deepen learning, spark creativity, and nurture the full range of a child's developing abilities. Children explore language through phonetic play and storytelling, build scientific thinking through hands-on discovery, and strengthen problem-solving through logic games and structured challenges.

Art and music encourage self-expression and imagination, while movement-based activities, from yoga to outdoor play, support coordination, balance, and emotional well-being.

All of this unfolds in a bilingual setting, where English and French are not simply taught, but lived. The children absorb both languages naturally through songs, stories, conversation, and daily routines, during the years when their minds are most open to rhythm and structure.

The Mint School offers something no other Montessori in Toronto does: a truly bilingual learning environment combined with our *Enriched Whole Child Curriculum*. This mix not only sets us apart but also gives your child a lasting advantage.

We weave language into every part of the day at Mint. Children sing in French, solve problems in English, and switch between both with ease. From the moment they step into the classroom, children absorb English and French naturally, through stories, songs, conversations, and play, not rote memorization or repetition.

Research supports what we see in practice. The first six years are the brain's most vital period for language development. When immersed in two languages during this time, children pick them up naturally. They develop fluency effortlessly.

The benefits extend well beyond communication. Bilingual learners develop stronger memories, sharper focus, and greater flexibility in how they think. They demonstrate deeper empathy, broader perspectives, and increased confidence in expressing ideas in any language.

in and the confidence to thrive in both.



Toddler Program: 18 Months-3 Years

LAYING THE FOUNDATION FOR LIFELONG LEARNING

The first six years of a child's life form the most critical window for cognitive, emotional, social, and physical development. Our Toddler Program is thoughtfully designed to harness this period, combining authentic Montessori principles with an enriched curriculum that addresses the whole child. The program nurtures independence, curiosity, and foundational skills across multiple domains, setting the stage for confident, engaged learners.

Using tactile materials like sorting trays, toddlers grasp quantity, order, and one-to-one correspondence through playful repetition.

Nature objects, stories, and seasonal themes spark curiosity about the world, fostering global awareness and care for the environment.

Practical Life Children build confidence by caring for themselves and their


environment, pouring, sweeping, polishing, cutting, and learning social graces. These tasks develop independence, focus, and responsibility.

shape, and colour, deepening perception and preparing the mind


for abstract thought.



Through daily phonetic work, reading, and writing, children connect

sound to symbol. They write letters on chalkboards, and then with pencils,

developing fluency, coordination, and self-expression.



Children explore numbers through tactile materials, progress as they master 0–10 work, then teens, and then eventually the decimal system

with all four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.



Hands-on lessons in geography and history help children explore ideas of time, place, and people. They study maps of continents, oceans, countries, and provinces, building global awareness from the start.



appreciation for French culture.



Children work with sandpaper letters, movable alphabets, and phonetic

objects to build sound-symbol connections. These joyful, tactile experiences pave the way for confident reading and writing.



 STEM STEM emerges through building, experimenting, measuring,

and classifying. Whether they're constructing structures or observing nature, Casa children ask questions and think like young scientists.



Puzzles, matching games, and sequencing exercises strengthen focus, pattern recognition, and critical thinking, preparing children

for more abstract problem-solving.



Regular art and music classes offer joyful outlets for self-expression.

Children engage in visual and performing arts and learn about the basics of music – developing confidence as well as an appreciation

for beauty and creativity.



Structured movement, yoga, and outdoor play support coordination, balance, and body awareness. Mindful movement helps children build

healthy habits and emotional regulation.




Good Food Served With Intention

Each day begins with a healthy snack and a hot, balanced lunch, prepared off-site by Wholesome Kids Catering. Known for fresh ingredients and meals children genuinely enjoy, they create seasonal menus built on whole foods, cultural variety, and thoughtful nutrition. We accommodate dietary restrictions with care.

We receive meals fresh and ready to serve. Children eat together in a calm, unhurried setting. They pour their own water, set the table, and clear their plates. In the process, they build independence, practice grace and courtesy, and learn that food isn't just fuel, it's part of a rhythm that values respect, routine, and community.

SUMMER, THE MONTESSORI WAY


